

Exercise 3 Answers

1. Yes. Not a RoW, but probably OK field edge.
2. Yes. Local knowledge (The Greenway). Confusing path and parish boundary, but not RoW.
3. With great caution. RoW, but crosses dual carriageway with no sign of bridge or underpass.
4. No. Power line – not a path.
5. Yes. Road/track “with public access”. (Actually a public highway.)
6. No. Parish boundary – not a path.
7. Yes. RoW – footpath. Also part of Hertfordshire Way.
8. Yes. RoW – footpath.
9. No. Track on private land. Not RoW. And it doesn’t go anywhere.
10. With caution. RoW, but ends up on a dual carriageway, with nowhere to go.
11. Maybe. RoW. Footpath across fields – might be a more interesting route.
12. Maybe. If you wanted to get to Sainsburys or the Lister. Cycle track to major road junction – not clear from map whether there are footways.
